Invitation to Tenders for "Painting, Tiling and miscellaneous Civil Works" in NIB Noida.

Sealed tenders are invited from experienced civil work contractors for "Painting, Tiling and miscellaneous Civil Works" in NIB Noida, on the attached tender form. Please quote your competitive rates for this work, on the enclosed Price-Bid format including all taxes, duties, T & P etc. required for proper completion of this work. The tender document/ form can be down loaded free of cost from NIB website www.nib.gov.in and Central Procurement Portal (CPP) from 25.07.2017 to 08.08.2017.

Your sealed tender should be dropped in NIB tender box or reach NIB, Noida, on or before the closing date, i. e. **09.08.2017** up to **3:00** *P. M.* and the same shall be opened on the same day at **4:00** *P. M.* in presence of the representatives of the bidders, who wish to be present during the opening of the tenders. Late tenders will not be received and treated as rejected.

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Limited Tender Enquiry

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1. Introduction:

"National Institute of Biologicals (NIB) is an autonomous institution under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, established on 27th January, 1992 and is to be the Central Drugs Laboratory for quality control of all indigenously produced and imported biological products. Presently, five laboratories of the Institute are notified as Central Drugs Laboratory under provision of Drugs & Cosmetics Act and Rules. Institute plays a vital role in collaboration with CDSCO to strengthen the regulation of biologicals in India by averting the Not of Standard Quality Biologicals reaching the consumer, thereby promoting and protecting public health."

2. Scope of Work:

Rooms walls and ceiling are to be re-painted with acrylic smooth exterior paint and Polyurathene paint. Peeled -off paint on the wall/Ceiling of Rooms shall be removed by scrapping. The surface shall be filled & finished with wall putty. The repaired wall/ceiling shall be repainted with acrylic smooth exterior paint. Grid Ceiling tiles are to be re-painted by applying Polyurathene (PU) Paint of Akzo Noble/equivalent make with roller finish including repairs of patches with PU putty & primer.

Ceramic glazed floor tiles are to be laid near water coolers after dismantling existing floor at different locations. Old plaster from wall is to be chipped -off and glazed wall tiles are to be fixed near Water Cooler. Drain pipes and fittings are to be provided for Water Cooler to connect the drain with nearest manhole.

All necessary connections for drain line including fixing PVC Nahani Trap with covering jali, making hole into wall and making good the walls including necessary fittings like laying sufficient length of PVC pipe to connect with existing manhole etc. will be provided and fixed by the contractor. All materials, labour T&P etc. shall be arranged by the contractor. Debris and mucks shall be disposed-off outside NIB Campus. The work site shall be cleaned neatly after completion of the work.

3. Contractor should have good experience in Carrying out similar type of Works.

4. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):

The Bidder shall furnish EMD of *Rs. 3,000/-* (*Three thousand only*) along with the tender in the shape of demand draft in favour of "*National Institute of Biologicals*" payable at *Noida*. EMD shall be returned to the unsuccessful bidders after award of work.

EMD of successful bidder shall be adjusted in the security deposit. The tender not accompanied with EMD shall be rejected. EMD can also be deposited by way of NEFT/RTGS and bidder need to indicate transaction ID details with Date & Time etc. Bank details of NIB are as below:

If the selected bidder fails to start & execute the work, his EMD will be forfeited as per Government rules.

5. Security Deposit:

A sum equivalent to 10% of the contract value shall be deducted from the bills of the contractor, which shall be returned after successful completion of the Defect Liability Period (DLP) of one year or the same can be released against submission of equal amount of Bank Guarantee (B.G.) valid for 60 (Sixty) days beyond the Defect Liability Period.

6. Defect Liability Period (DLP):

The work/ materials of the contractor shall be under **one year's** Defect Liability Period. Defect/s noticed during the Defect Liability Period shall be rectified by the contractor without any cost to NIB, failing which the Security Deposit of the Contractor shall be forfeited. The contractor may also be debarred from any future tendering in the Institute.

7. Submission of Tender:

The contractor shall submit the tender in the sealed envelope in the following manner.

Envelope No. 1 -Shall contain EMD in the form of bank draft for *Rs. 3,000/-* (*Three thousand only*) along with a copy of tender document duly signed and stamped by the bidder as a token of acceptance of terms & conditions. If the EMD and tender document are found in the order, Price-Bid (*Envelope No-2*) will be opened simultaneously with Envelope No. 1.

<u>Envelope No. 2</u> – Shall contain Price-Bid (*Price part only*). Price shall be filled by the bidder only in the format given by NIB with the Notice Inviting tenders. Price on any other format shall be rejected.

Both the sealed envelopes No. 1 & 2 shall be then put in a bigger envelope duly addressed to "*Director, National Institute of Biologicals, A-32, Sector - 62, Noida - 201 309*" and marked on top tender for " Painting, Tiling and miscellaneous Civil Works" in NIB Noida.

8. Time of Completion:

The work shall be completed within 1 (*One*) *month* from issue of work order.

9. Liquidated Damages/ Penalty for Delay:

If the contractor fails to complete the work within the stipulated time or time extended by the Institute (if any), liquidated damages at the rate of 1% per week or part there of delay subject to maximum 10% of the total contract value shall be deducted /recovered from the contractor.

10. Specification:

The materials supplied and proposed to be used in the work shall be of good quality and reputed make in the Industry and the contractor will provide necessary proof thereof. The work should be carried out as per the specifications and as per good engineering practices.

11. Power (Electricity) & Water:

Power (Electricity) &Water for construction works will be provided by NIB free of cost near the work site.

12. Payment:

- (i) Payment of the contracted price for respective item will be made on receipt of bill & inspection of site. Final payment will be made within 30 (*Thirty*) days after completion of the work. No advance payment shall be made to start the work. TDS will be deducted as per rules.
- (ii) Necessary Bank details in given below format need to be provided for release of payment directly in bidder's Bank Account along with the bill.

13. Bill of Quantity:

The quantities are given in the Price-Bid. The quantities can be increased/decreased by 20%. Payment shall be made as per the measurement of finished & actual work done at site. Payment for varied quantity shall also be made as per the quoted and accepted rates.

14. Risks:

Contractor shall be solely responsible for safety of his workers, working at site by taking insurance cover and following safety norms in the trade.

All risks of loss or damage to physical property and of personel injury and death which arise during and in consequence of the performance of the Contract other than the excepted risks are the responsibility of the Contractor. Excepted Risks are:

- a. (i) war, hostilities (whether war be declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemies.
 - (ii) rebellion, revolution, insurrection, or military or usurped power, or civil war,
 - (iii) ionising radiations, or contamination by radio-activity from any nuclear fuel, or from any nuclear waste from the combustion of nuclear fuel, radio-active toxic explosive, or other hazardous properties of any explosive nuclear assembly or nuclear component thereof.
 - (iv) Pressure waves caused by aircraft or other aerial devices traveling at sonic or supersonic speed.

loss or damage due to the use or occupation by the Employer of any section or part of the Permanent Works, except as may be provided for in the Contract.

b. loss or damage to the extent that it is due to the design of the Works, other than any part of the design provided by the Contractor or for which the Contractor is responsible.

15. <u>Disputes</u>:

If any dispute or difference of any kind, whatsoever, shall arise between NIB and the Contractor, in connection with or arising out of the Contract, or the execution of the works, whether during the progress of the works or after their completion and whether before or after the termination, abandonment or breach of the contract, it shall, be settled under the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof and the rules made there under and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. Such arbitration shall be settled by Sole arbitrator who shall be appointed by Director, NIB. The arbitration shall take place in Noida/ Delhi unless both parties agree otherwise.

16. Right to accept or reject the Tender:

Director, NIB reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
